NOTE: The effective date for MassHealth and Health Safety Net is expected to be 3/1/17.

- Per CRVFHP contracts, the Provider agrees to maintain a fee schedule and corresponding sliding schedule of discounts based on ability to pay.
- Section 330-funded health centers provide a full discount to pts. at or below the poverty level and a sliding fee for pts. between 100% and 200% of FPL.
- State / local programs have their own income-based eligibility guidelines; this schedule is provided as a resource that may be helpful with other programs.
- Accuracy of income and family size information is key / essential to program reporting.
- MSFWs are to be informed that services will not be denied because of inability to pay.
