Open Enrollment: November 1, 2017 – January 23, 2018

This year's Health Connector Open Enrollment period runs from November 1, 2017 through January 23, 2018. Open Enrollment is the time of year when individuals and families may apply for and enroll in coverage and current members, including ConnectorCare, can renew or switch existing Health Connector coverage for any reason, without needing a qualifying event.

The Open Enrollment period in Massachusetts is distinct and has different deadlines than Federal Open Enrollment Period. In years past, this has caused some confusion and with the continued uncertainty at the federal level, it is even more important to ensure patients and the community have accurate and relevant information about how to access health coverage in Massachusetts, and health centers, play a crucial role in sharing this information. The Health Connector anticipates substantial member movement based on preliminary eligibility redetermination processes and because of premium increases due to elimination of CSR payments, so all members should review their current application, update income, compare options for 2018 coverage as more affordable plans may be available.

Important Dates:

- November 1, 2017: First date to start shopping and comparing plans at MAhealthconnector.org.
- December 23, 2017: Premium due by this date to enroll coverage for January 1, 2018.
- January 1, 2018: The first day of new 2018 coverage. If there have been any changes to program eligibility, January 1 is the date when those changes will start.
- January 23, 2018: Open Enrollment Ends – the last day to apply, enroll and pay for a plan beginning February 1, 2018.

As a reminder, individuals who qualify for MassHealth, are newly eligible for ConnectorCare, are applying for dental coverage or are a member of a federally recognized tribe or Alaska Native shareholder can apply and enroll at any time during the year.

Massachusetts residents can apply online, by phone, on paper or in-person. All of your health centers have trained and certified enrollment assister staff, for a total of just about 500 at health centers across the state, who are preparing to assist with renewals and new applications, conduct patient in reach and community outreach and help educate members on how to best use their coverage.

The League has updated media and messaging content for Massachusetts community health centers as they work to communicate important information about health insurance enrollment to their patients. The enclosed messaging is organized around key drivers of action: value, affordability, convenience and deadlines. These messages promote the benefits of coverage, encourage members to update information, shop and compare plans, highlight free and convenient in-person assistance, provide reminders about important deadlines, and encourage patients to promptly report life changes that may impact their eligibility – all are effective ways to reach patients.

It is helpful to have information about you and the people in your household who are applying for health coverage. Once you have an appointment, please bring:

- Identification, like a driver's license or passport, if available
- The birthdates and social security numbers for all members in your household who want to apply, if available
- Immigration documents for all non-U.S. citizens who are applying, if available
- A recent pay stub or a copy of your latest federal tax return
- Home or mailing addresses for everyone in the household who wants insurance, unless they are homeless
- Your e-mail address, if you have one
- Proof of Massachusetts residency, like a utility bill, rental agreement and rent receipt, or a letter from your landlord

Remember: **We can help you apply even if you do not have this information.**

Open Enrollment for Health Insurance Coverage Starts November 1 ***Friendly Community Health Center is ready to help***

If you or any of your family members are in need of health insurance, there's good news. Open enrollment for health insurance across Massachusetts begins on **Wednesday, November 1, 2017** – and we can help.

Massachusetts' 50 community health centers, including **Friendly Community Health Center**, have nearly 500 outreach and enrollment staff ready to help you find the right plan that fits both your health needs and your budget. Whether it's coverage through the Massachusetts Health Connector or the state's Medicaid MassHealth program, all plans cover doctor visits, hospital stays, prescription drugs, immunizations, health screenings and more.

Last year, hundreds of thousands of Massachusetts residents received financial help to lower the cost of their health insurance, and you could too. Plans and prices change every year, so check out your options. Even if you already have insurance through the Massachusetts Health Connector or if you've looked before, there may be new options this year that work better for your needs and budget. You may also qualify for more financial assistance. As many members may experience an increase in their monthly health coverage premium, this year it is important that all members review the health plan options available to them so that they can make sure they are selecting the plan that works best for their financial, mental and physical health. Find out if you qualify for tax credits or subsidies that can lower your premiums and reduce your out-of-pocket expenses, including co-pays for doctors' visits and prescription drugs. And if your income is very low, you may qualify for free or low-cost coverage through the MassHealth program.

Health insurance also helps protect you and your family from the unexpected. Accidents, injuries and illness can happen on any day. When they do, the last thing you need to worry about is how to pay for your health care or taking on medical debt.

Enrolling in health care has never been easier. If you have questions about choosing a plan that's right for you and your family, trained assisters can guide you – at no cost – from beginning to end in the enrollment process. Don't wait! Open enrollment starts on **Wednesday, November 1, 2017 and runs through Tuesday, January 23, 2018**.
