In lieu of the typical day-long Uniform Data System (UDS) training, the League will be partnering with HRSA/JSI to host a 5-part webinar series. This webinar will cover the preparation of the 2020 UDS Report, and will address each of the report's tables, focusing on changes since 2019 – including the various changes related to COVID-19 and telehealth, definitions necessary to complete the UDS Report, and common problems/errors. This training is targeted toward those who are responsible for gathering and reporting the data elements included in the UDS Report, as well as management, finance, and clinical staff who need to understand the definitions and concepts used, and those who use the data in their program management and quality improvement activities.
