A Fellowship to recruit, educate, and retain PMHNPs at community health centers



Grant Opportunity

Funded through the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS), this is a fellowship opportunity for recent PMHNP graduates and student nurses enrolled in a PMHNP program.

Graduate Fellows will be under a 12-month service commitment and student Fellows will be under a semester-long placement.

CHC Eligibility

All MA FQHCs, hospital-licensed, and FQHC look-alike health centers are eligible to apply. Priority will be given to CHCs located in EOHHS' Advancing Health Equity in MA (AHEM) Areas, rural areas, and Cape Cod and the Islands.

Intent of the Fellowship

The PMHNP Fellowship Program aims to recruit and retain well-qualified and diverse practicing level (graduates) and student-level PMHNPs to care for the behavioral health needs of populations served by Massachusetts' CHCs.
